Within a health reform project in Tajikistan funded by the Swiss Agency for Development and Cooperation (SDC), your tasks will include:

- To assure technical and managerial project planning and implementation
- To provide technical support to Tajik MoH in the area of health reform, health service management, family medicine, and community participation
- To co-ordinate project related activities and closely liaise with other multi- and bilateral agencies as well as NGOs.
- To oversee a local team of 15 employees

The long-term assignment as project manager with a competitive salary will be based in Dushanbe, Tajikistan. To best fit into our active, interdisciplinary team we expect the following qualifications:

- Formal qualification in health policy, health economics, health service management, medicine, epidemiology or a health related field (Master degree level). A postgraduate training in public health or a MBA is an asset.
- Minimum of 8 years' working experience in the field of public health and health reform in developing or transition countries in at least one of the following fields: health system monitoring and evaluation, health financing, health planning and management, community health, primary care
- Previous management experience and ability to work in a team
- Ability to communicate with high level policy makers and international partners
- Excellent command of English and command of Russian

An initial contract of two years will be offered. An extension is desirable, depending on a performance evaluation.
