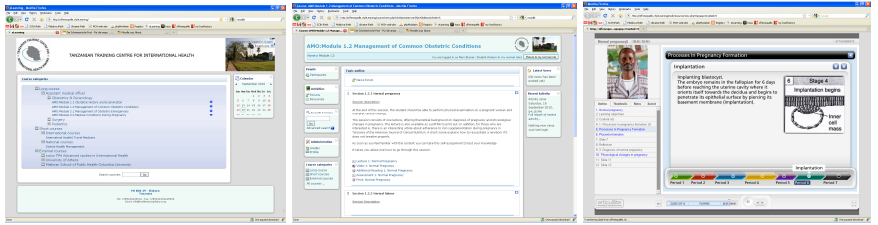

| Application description | <p>Moodle is an open source Learning Management System. It is widely popular among educators around the world as a tool for creating online dynamic web sites for their students. Moodle has features that allow it to scale to very large deployments and hundreds of thousands of students, yet it can also be used for a single primary school.</p> <p>Many institutions use it as a platform to conduct fully online courses, while some use it simply to augment face-to-face courses (known as blended learning). Moodle allows for the delivery of content to students (such as through standard SCORM packages) and assessment using assignments or quizzes. Activity modules (such as forums, databases and wikis) enable collaboration among students and with educators.</p> |
