

The conference venue

The conference venue is the Kollegienhaus of the [University of Basel](https://www.unibas.ch/), located very centrally in Basel at Petersplatz 1.




Ground floor:

Pink: The Aula (Plenaries, parallel sessions)

Orange: Foyer (Coffee breaks, lunches)

Green: Press room (Serves as preparation room for uploading presentations)

Yellow: Registration desk (For registration, hanging coats, guarding suitcases)



First floor:

Blue: Rooms 115, 116 and 117 (Workshops, parallel sessions)

How to get to the conference venue

By public transport

The main station of Basel is very well connected within Europe, with direct connections to Amsterdam, Paris, Berlin and many other major European cities. The University of Basel is also easy to reach using public transport. Depending on where you travel from, you might arrive at Basel SBB (the main station) or Basel Badischer Bahnhof (near the German border). From either Basel SBB or the Badischer Bahnhof, take bus line 30 to stop “Universität” (University). The conference venue is now a 180 m walk away (approximately 3 min).

By car

For both environmental and practical reasons, we do not encourage travelling to the conference by car. It is expensive to park in the university area, but both the “Parkhaus City” and the “Basel Parkhaus” are possibilities. From the airport

We encourage travel by public transport wherever possible. If you must fly, transport from the Basel EuroAirport to the city is convenient. Just take the airport bus (line 50) to the “Brausebad” stop. (Be careful: Line 50 “Express” does not stop at “Brausebad”). The conference venue is a 900 m walk from there (approximately 12 min). Alternatively, take bus line 50 to the end stop (Bahnhof SBB), then change to bus line 30 and get out at the stop “Universität” (University). The conference venue is now a 180 m walk away (approximately 3 min).
