SDGs:

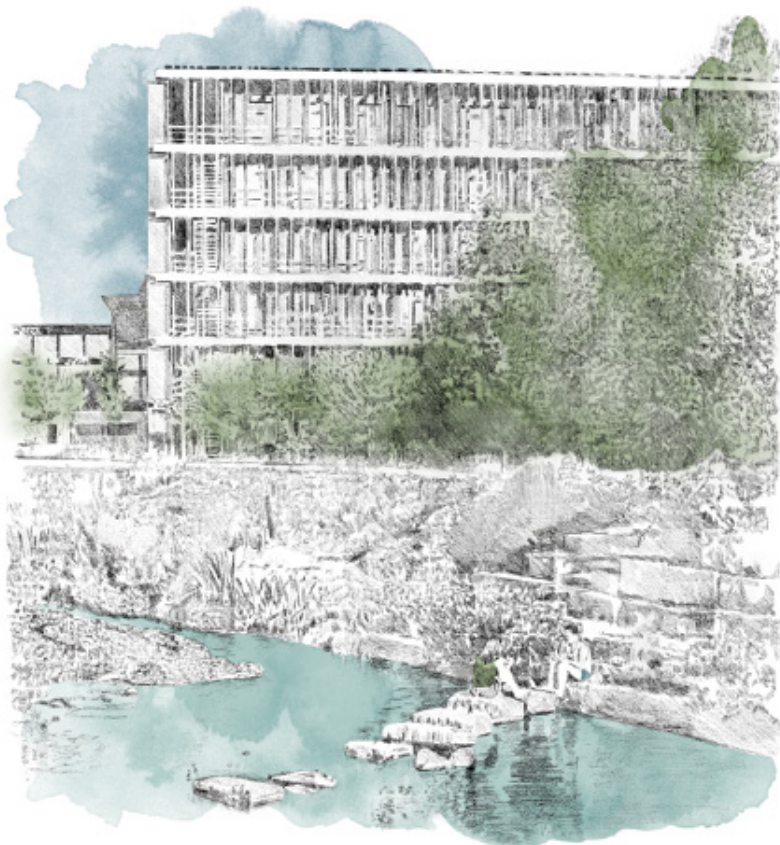
- need multidisciplinary, integrated approaches,

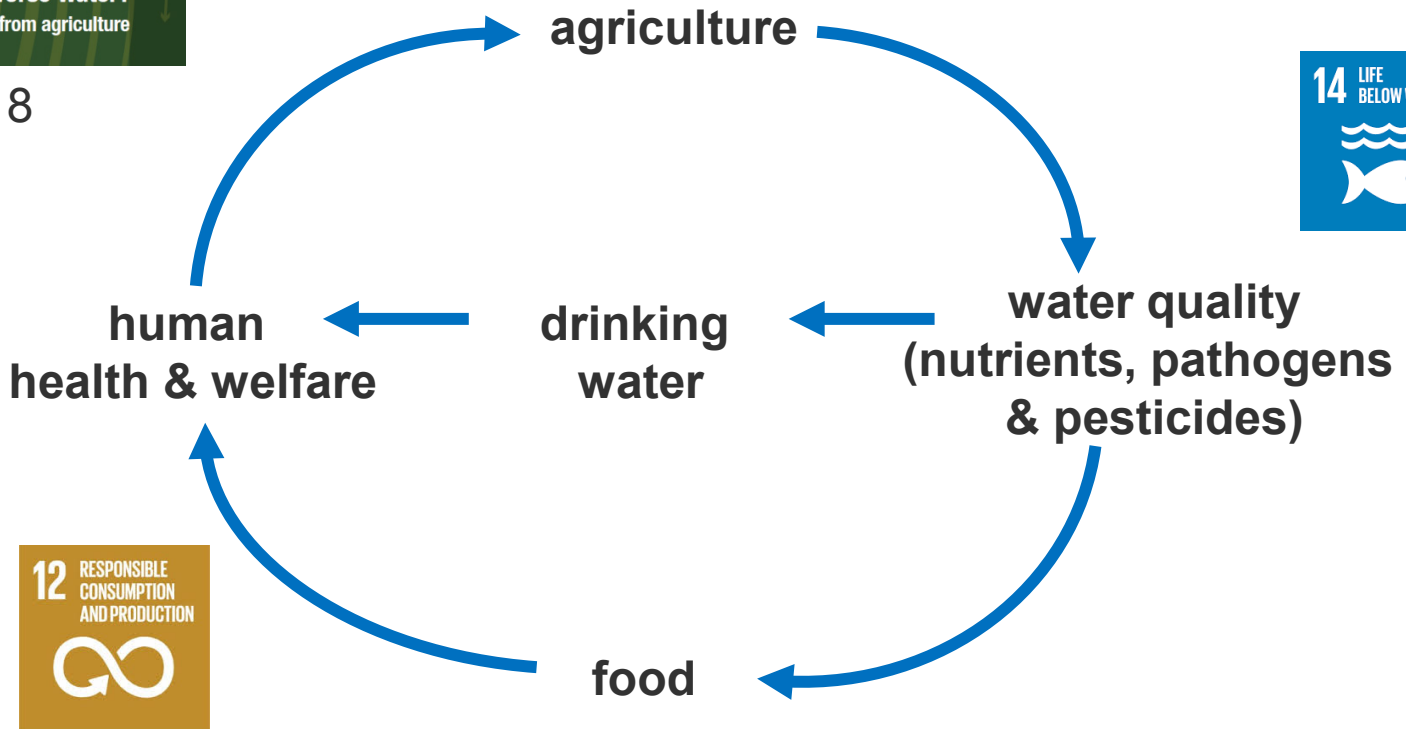
