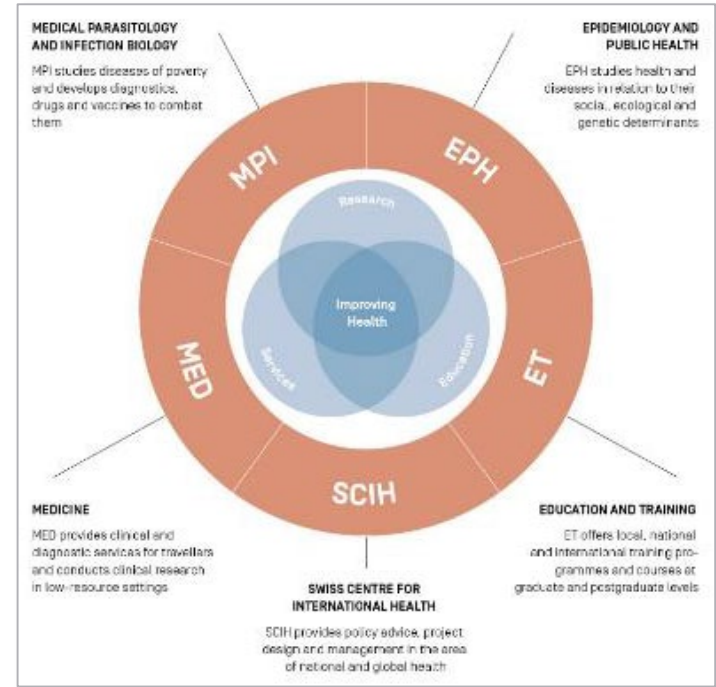

We tested the world's most promising malaria vaccine

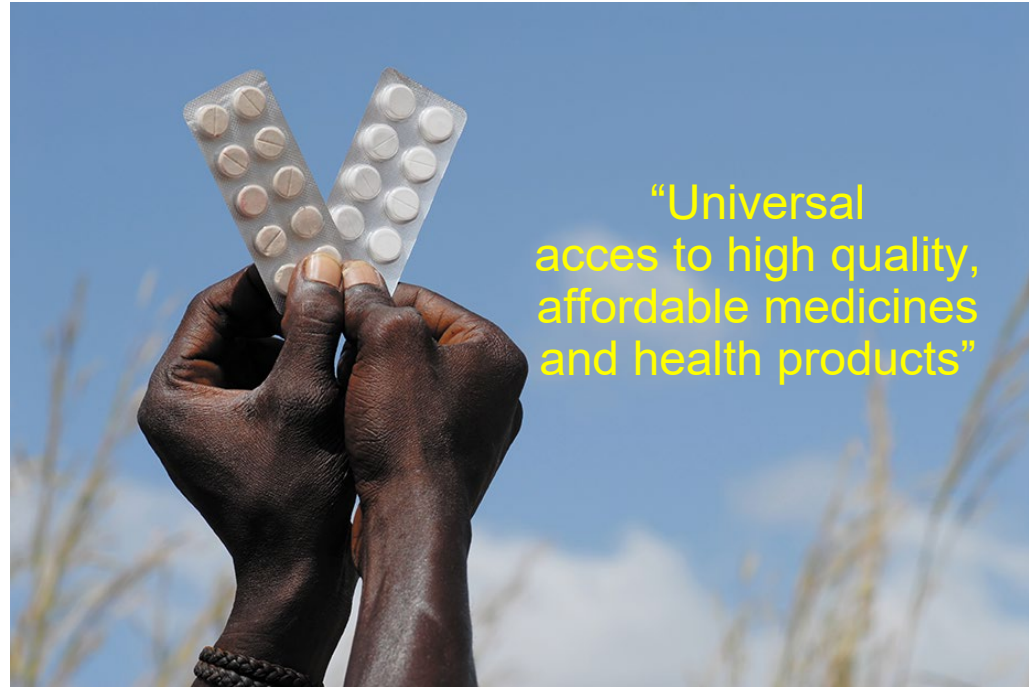


Application

We prevented diseases like malaria and strengthen health systems

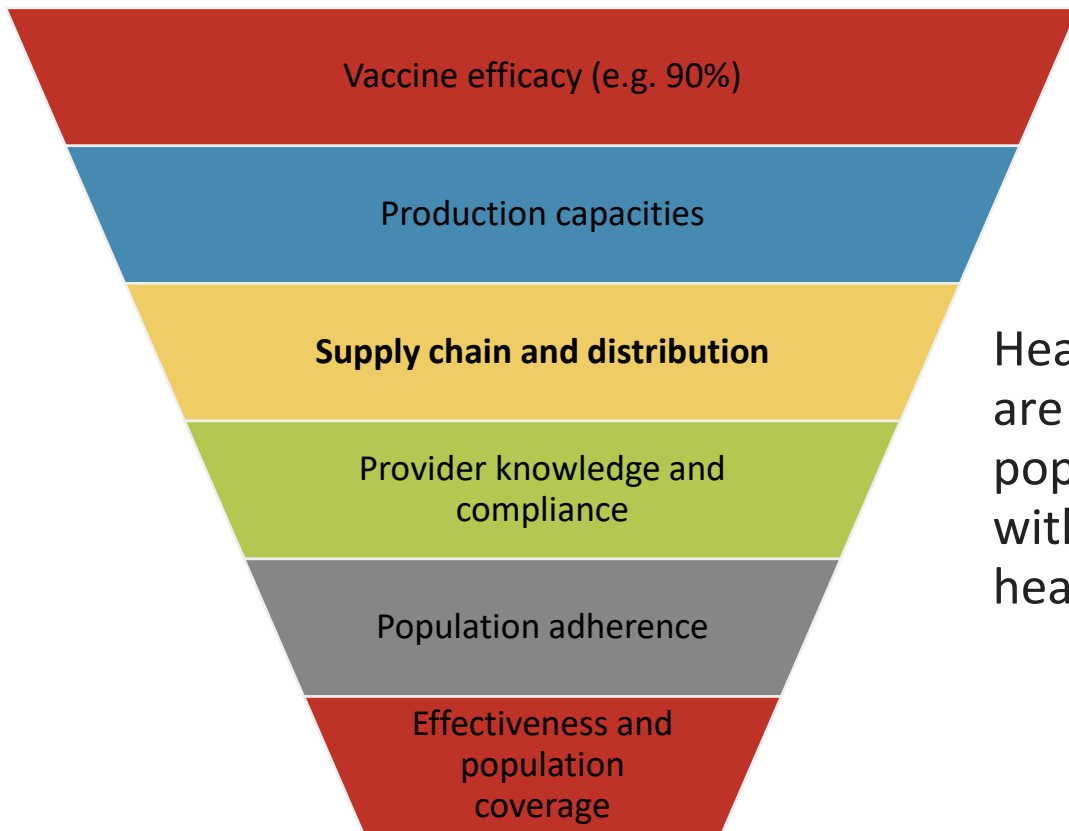
