Objectives: To understand and apply basic statistical concepts and methods (explorative and descriptive statistics, statistical inference); to understand and apply linear regression models for continuous outcome data; to be able to identify appropriate statistical methods for basic analytic problems—and to interpret the results of such analyses; to gain insight into statistical thinking; to apply the statistical software STATA for data analysis.

Description: This course covers basic concepts and methods of biostatistics and quantitative epidemiology and basic techniques of confounder control and of assessing effect modification.

Content:

- Data description and presentation, graphical representations and summary measures
- Normal distribution
- Sampling distribution and confidence intervals
- Testing of statistical hypotheses (focusing on the comparison of mean values and proportions)
- Measures of association and agreement for categorical data
- Confounder control and assessment of effect modification / interactions
- Introduction to Linear Regression Models



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
